Schools must provide optimal conditions for learning and teaching Air quality is particularly important in educational buildings: children have been shown to be more sensitive to indoor air pollution because they breathe more air relative to their weight and their organs are still growing. At the same time, the social consequences of poor indoor (air) quality are much more costly than investing in energy-saving indoor air technology.
